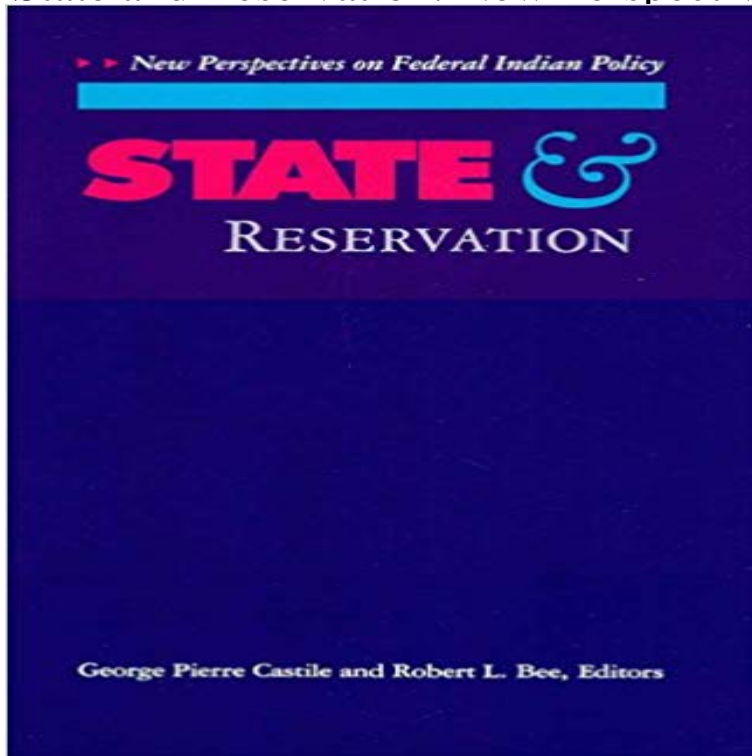


State and Reservation: New Perspectives on Federal Indian Policy
