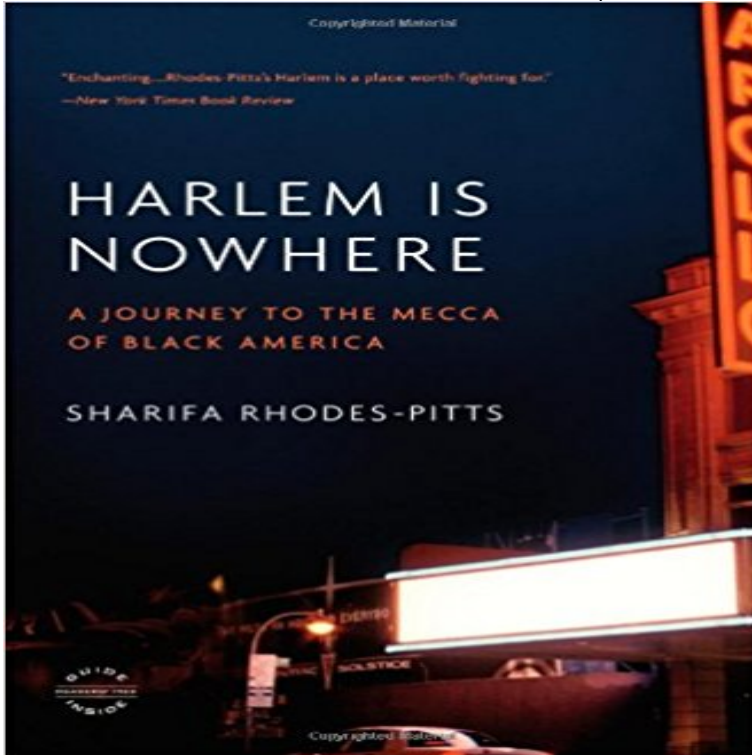


Harlem Is Nowhere: A Journey to the Mecca of Black America
