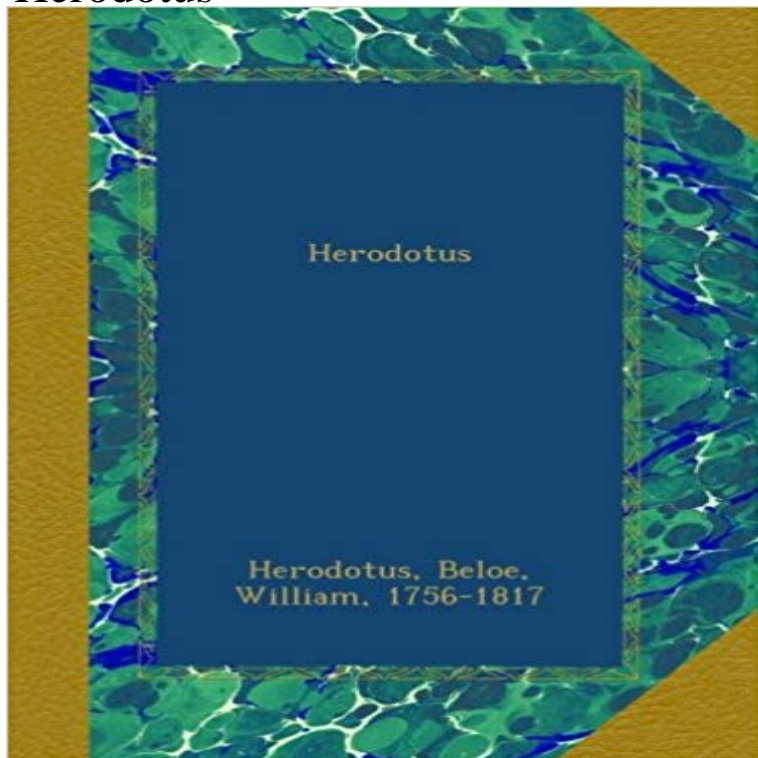


Herodotus
